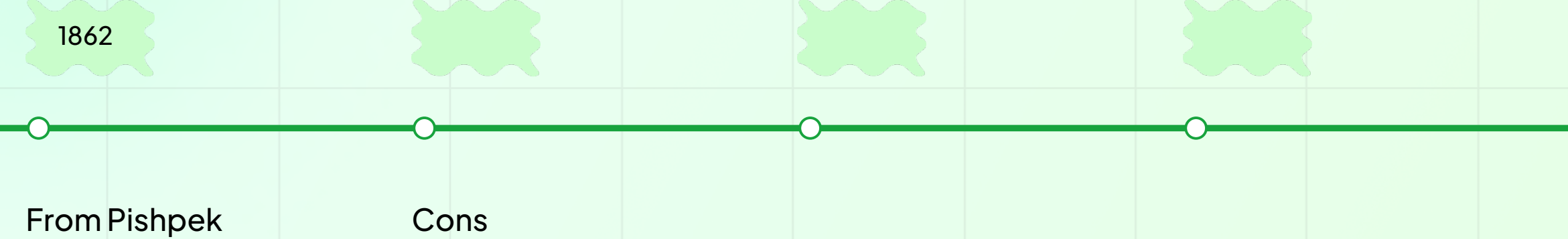

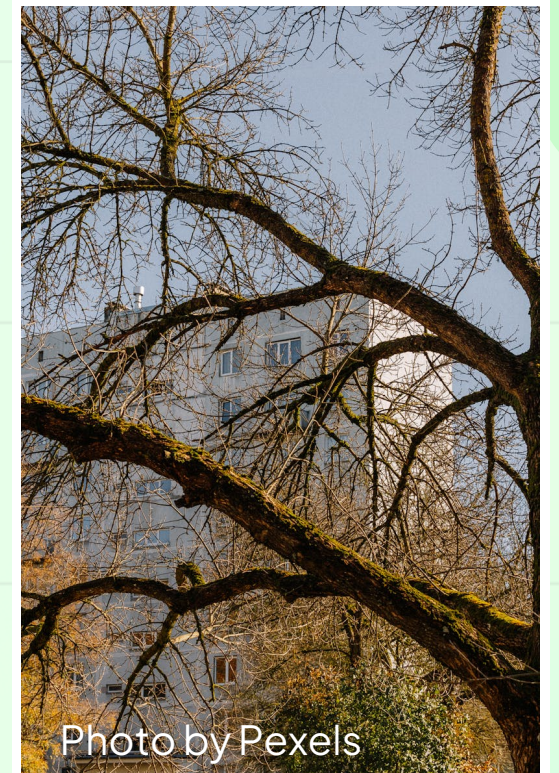
Disadvantages of Educational Institutions
